

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Respect: 1. an act of giving particular attention: 2. high or special regard.

Respect:

- **Respect the campground:** buildings and equipment- including stage and music equipments. Please do not touch music equipment without asking the worship team first.
- **Respect campers, other camp guests, Koronis Staff, camp committee staff and chaperones.** Please use your tongue for praise and not put downs.
- **Respect yourself** dress modestly. Please do cause a brother or sister to stumble by being a distraction.
- **Respect your brothers and sisters in Christ:** Sexual misconduct is prohibited (no kissing, hugging, holding hands, and cuddling with someone of the opposite sex.)

Unwanted items:

- Weapons, drugs, and alcohol are prohibited.
- Cell phones along with other electronic devices (i-touch, i-pod, i-pad (**even w/ Bible Apps**), PSP, lap tops, etc.) are not allowed in the main sanctuary, workshops rooms, and the cafeteria.

Reminders:

- **CAN NOT** leave camp ground unless it's an emergency and with permission from chaperones.
- Always travel in a group of 3 or more and inform a chaperone when taking a nature walk.
- Follow all the rules of each camp ground activities you participate in.
- 11pm is Courtesy hour. Be in your room and please be quite (courtesy to your fellow campers).
- **GET OUT OF YOUR COMFORT ZONE!!!** You traveled this far to have an amazing experience. Get to know new people and make new Christian friends! 😊

Safety Tips:

- Stay hydrated:
 - **DRINK LOTS OF WATER!!!**
- Poison Ivy:
 - It appears as a ground cover or a shrub vine growing up a tree.
 - It has a dull or glossy compound on the leaves and it's dark and waxy.
 - They have 3 leaflets that are 2-4' long.
 - The sap is poisonous in their roots, stem, and leaves.
 - Rash starts out with red, swollen patches.
 - If you think you have contracted poison ivy, go to the nurse ASAP before the blister becomes larger and breaks out.
 - Please stay on the path and not walk into the woods.
- Lake Safety:
 - No horseplay at the lake.
 - Listen to the life guards.
 - Don't swim alone and swim within the boundaries.
 - If you break any rules, all privileges of canoeing, tubing, & fishing will be taken away.

Dress code:

- **Girls:** No short skirts, tube tops, halter tops, low cut shirt (no cleavage), spaghetti straps, and short shorts: **Shorts: knee length only*****, legging: can wear w/ dress/ skit (but not t-shirt, short short skit or shorts), swimming suit- only at swim area.
- **Guys:** No short shorts, shirts should remain on, any degrading shirts, muscle shirt: must have a tank top under, and swimming suit- only at swim area.

Consequences:

- There are consequences for misbehaving. A pastor or chaperone will talk to you and you may be asked to leave Shekinah if you don't comply with the camp rules and regulations.
